

# ST ANN'S HOSPICE

## LEGACY FACTSHEET 4: **WILL-WORDING**

The wording to leave a gift in your Will to St Ann's Hospice should read as follows:

- a) Residuary Legacy: you can leave the remainder, or a portion of the remainder, of your estate after specific people have been provided for

"I give to St Ann's Hospice of St Ann's Road North, Heald Green, Cheadle, Cheshire SK8 3SZ ("The Hospice"), registered charity no 258085, all (or an x%share of) the residue of my estate, for the general charitable purposes of the Hospice and I declare that the receipt of the Finance Director or other proper officer of the Hospice shall be a full and sufficient discharge."

- b) Pecuniary Legacy: you can leave a specific sum of money

"I give to St Ann's Hospice of St Ann's Road North, Heald Green, Cheadle, Cheshire SK8 3SZ ("The Hospice"), registered charity no 258085, the sum of £..... free of all tax (repeat in words) for the general charitable purposes of the Hospice and I declare that the receipt of the Finance Director or other proper officer of the Hospice shall be a full and sufficient discharge."

- c) Specific Bequest: you can leave a gift of particular assets or goods (shares, jewellery)

"I give to St Ann's Hospice of St Ann's Road North, Heald Green, Cheadle, Cheshire SK8 3SZ ("The Hospice"), registered charity no 258085, the [describe item you wish to leave to the Hospice] for the general charitable purposes of the Hospice and I declare that the receipt of the Finance Director or other proper officer of the Hospice shall be a full and sufficient discharge."

- d) Contingent Bequest: you can leave a particular gift should a certain event occur
