

Nurses' Day Spring Walk – Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions apply to participants of the Nurses' Day Spring Walk for St Ann's Hospice (hereafter referred to as 'the Event'). Please read them carefully before registering. By registering, you agree to comply with the following terms.

St Ann's Hospice will hereafter be referred to as 'the Charity'.

The Charity reserves the right to update or amend these terms at any time. Please check the Event webpage before attending for the most up-to-date version. We reserve the right to ask participants to leave the Event if they fail to comply, and no refunds shall be given in such cases.

Participant Registration

- Entry fees for the Event are:
 - Adult (18+): £5
 - Child (under 18): £2.50 (must be accompanied by a paying adult at all times)
- Optional event T-shirt: £3.50
- Registration is not confirmed until payment is processed and a confirmation email is received.
- All participants should be registered in advance, although there will be a limited number of sign-up forms on event day.
- Spectators may attend but may not walk the route unless registered.
- We will collect contact details for all participants for safety purposes.
- Registration will close once capacity is reached.

Fundraising and Donations

- Participants are encouraged to raise as much as they can, aiming for a minimum of £50 in sponsorship, to support our Build It Together campaign for the new hospice.
- All donations raised must be passed on to the Charity within 4 weeks of the Event.

Accessibility and Safety

- The route is mostly flat but includes mixed terrain, including some stony and uneven ground.
- Participants are responsible for their own fitness and health.
- Bring a fully charged mobile phone in case of emergency.
- Participants are advised to wear suitable footwear and dress appropriately for the weather.
- If you have any accessibility concerns, please contact the events team at: events@sah.org.uk.
- Any dogs/ pets must be kept on a lead at all times, and are not allowed inside the Trafford Centre.

Cancellations and Changes

- Event places are non-refundable.
- Event places are non-transferable without prior permission.
- The Charity may need to modify, shorten or cancel the route in case of unexpected conditions.
- In case of extreme weather or safety concerns, the Event may be postponed or cancelled.

Conduct During the Event

- Participants must follow all instructions from marshals, volunteers, and staff on the day.
- Behave respectfully and avoid disruptive, dangerous, or inappropriate conduct.
- Smoking, alcohol, and all illegal substances are not permitted.
- Anybody behaving inappropriately and/or disrespectfully will be removed from the event.
- Do not litter. Use bins or take waste home.
- The Event is a non-competitive walk. Running, cycling, or other forms of participation are not permitted.
- The walk should be completed within 2 hours of the official start time.

Photography and Filming

- Photos and videos will be taken to promote the hospice via social media and marketing.
- If you do not wish to be photographed, inform a team member on the day.
- We will not use participant names without prior consent.

Use of Your Information

- Your details will be used to manage your Event entry and safety.
- Information may be shared with emergency services if needed.
- We may contact you about St Ann's Hospice and future events with your consent.
